

# **Green House Community Garden Our Values, Expectations, and Code of Conduct**

Welcome to Burien's Community Garden program. Your Green House Community Garden plot will provide you a space to cultivate and the opportunity to garden with other community members.

#### Please remember:

- The Green House Community Garden is a recreational program space. Only gardeners and guests of gardeners should be on the grounds.
- Respect the shared garden space and others plots.
- Planting in areas outside your plot requires the approval of PaRCS staff.
- Storage of personal items or equipment is not permitted. Storage of temporary items requires approval by PaRCS staff.
- Please do not remove city equipment or others' belongings from the garden.

# **BURIEN CODE OF CONDUCT—Burien Community Center & Parks**

Your Burien Community Center and parks are public facilities open to everyone – program participants, visitors, renters, and service dogs. Dogs must be a on a leash outdoors. Facilities and parks are for the benefit and well-being of all and are intended to be a safe and enjoyable environment for everyone. To ensure this, individuals who choose not to comply with the following expectations may be subject to removal from the premises.

### **Respect Everyone**

- We provide a family environment that promotes health and enjoyment, so respectful behavior is needed from all Burien Community Center and parks patrons.
- Many programs offer instruction, so keep voices and electronics at a moderate level.
- The disruption of programs and/or the use of violent or offensive language/gestures are not permitted.
- Please maintain personal hygiene that is appropriate and non-offensive for a public social environment, and do not urinate or defecate outside or inside the building other than in restroom facilities.
- Smoking of any substance is not permitted inside or outside the building entrances, exits, windows that open, and vents per RCW 70.160.075.
- Limit the use of the restroom to five minutes.

#### Be Safe

- Acts of violence or behaviors that make people feel threatened or are likely to cause personal injury are not permitted.
- People are not allowed to carry weapons in the facility, except per RCW 9.41. If staff are
  concerned about an object being used as a weapon, it is their discretion to ask you to remove it
  from the building.

- Alcohol consumption is permissible inside the building only with appropriate permits for approved special or rental events.
- Individuals under the influence of alcohol and/or non-prescription drugs will be asked to leave the facility.
- Controlled substance (drug) use, possession, and sales (per RCW 69.50) are prohibited in the building and on surrounding grounds.
- People shall not interfere with the free passage of doorways of the building.
- Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult unless enrolled in a recreation class.

# **Respect the Building**

- Burien facilities belong to Burien residents.
- Please keep facilities and surrounding grounds free of litter and vandalism.
- Signs, posters, and banners are allowed only in authorized spaces and require approval from Burien Community Center staff.
