2017 NEC - Changes as adopted and amended in BMC 15.10.140

- NEC 210.8 – GFCI Protection required on All 120-volt, single phase, 15- and 20-ampere receptacles installed within 6 ft. of any dwelling unit sink from the top inside edge of the bowl. GFCI protection also are required for lighting outlets not exceeding 120 volts installed in crawl space.
- NEC 210.52(C)(3) At least one receptacle outlet is required at each peninsular countertop with a long dimension and a short dimension of 12 inch or greater.
- NEC 210.12(C) All 120-volt, single phase, 15- and 20-ampere branch circuits supplying outlets and devices installed in guest rooms and guest suites of hotels and motels shall be protected by AFCI.
- NEC 210.52(G)(1) In each attached garage and in each detached garage with electric power, at least one receptacle outlet is required to be installed in each vehicle bay and not more than 5 ½ ft. above the floor.
- NEC 690.12 PV system circuits installed on or in buildings shall include a rapid shut-down function to reduce shock hazard for emergency responders.
