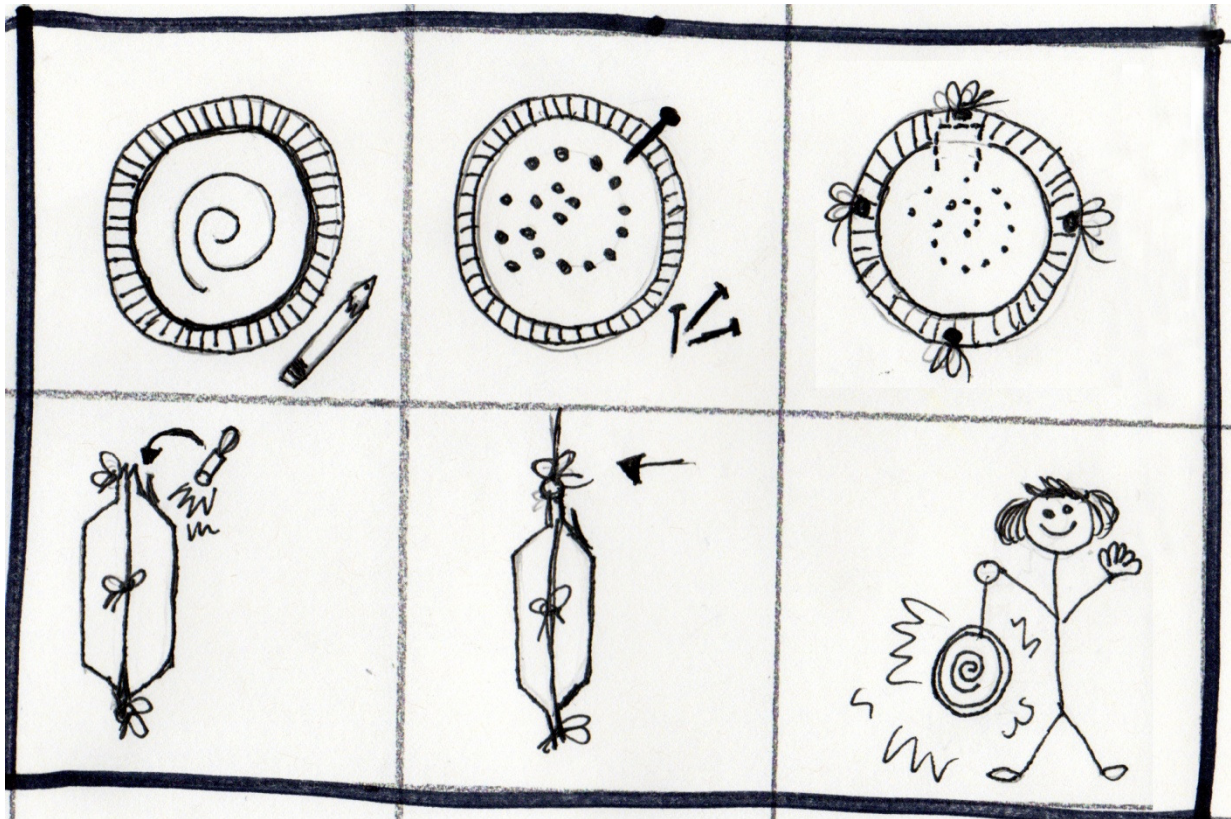


Make a Lantern with Pie Tins



Materials:

- 2 pie tins
- Dry erase marker
- Nails (2 or 3 different diameters) or awl(s)
- Cardboard or foam pad (work surface)
- Wire/ twist ties
- LED light (key-chain style) or glow stick

Instructions:

1. Draw a design on the flat inner circle of a pie tin with a dry erase marker.
2. Put a piece of cardboard or foam under the pie tin to protect your work surface and to give the nail/ awl something to poke into.
3. Place the pie tin on top of your cardboard/ foam and use a nail or awl to pierce small holes into the tin, following the lines of your design.
4. Pierce little holes until your design is complete. You can change the size of the hole by using different sized nails/awls.
5. Repeat steps 1-5 with a second pie tin.
6. Poke a wire or a twist tie through the bottom of both pie tins to connect them at the bottom. You might need to make holes first with a nail/awl.
7. Connect the sides the same way you connected the bottom (Alternatively, stapling the sides works, too.)
8. Use a piece of wire to attach the tins as the top the same way you attached them at the bottom.
9. Make another hole at the top to attach a wire for hanging.
10. Hang an LED (keychain style works well) or glow stick inside to illuminate your lantern.
