City of Burien Small Business Relief & Recovery Grant Program Available Now!

The City of Burien has made grant funding available to support small businesses impacted by COVID-19-required business closures. Grants of **up to \$5,000** will be awarded to qualifying businesses. Funding is limited and applications will close **July 13**.

GRANT PROGRAM GOALS:

Help small businesses keep their doors open

Support economic recovery and resilience

Protect local jobs

Provide relief to businesses that have not had access to other funding assistance

QUALIFYING BUSINESSES MUST:

- » Have a Burien business license
- » Have five or fewer FTE (full-time equivalent) employees
- » Have been in operation in the City of Burien for more than 12 months
- » Have experienced a decrease of 25% or more in revenue due to COVID-19 related business closures
- » Be a for-profit business
- » Not be a franchise or national chain
- » Not have received funding from the Paycheck Protection Program, SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loan program, SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loan Advance (grant) or received more than \$5,000 from any other COVID-19 related grant program

Ventures Nonprofit has been selected by the City to administer the grant program.
